Brussels supporting wind power supply



Overview

(BRUSSELS) – The European Commission presented a European Wind Power Action Plan Tuesday to help the industry reach the agreed EU target of at least 42.5 per cent renewable energy by 2030. The plan was initially announced in the EU State of the Union. Wind contributes 19% of Europe's electricity consumption and is considered integral to meeting 2030 and 2050 climate targets. As costs rise and competition from Chinese manufacturers intensifies, the EU is intent on accelerating wind development and bolstering energy security across the bloc. The investments in new green energy by Belgian energy suppliers have dropped by 51% in the past five years, according to a Greenpeace analysis published on Wednesday.

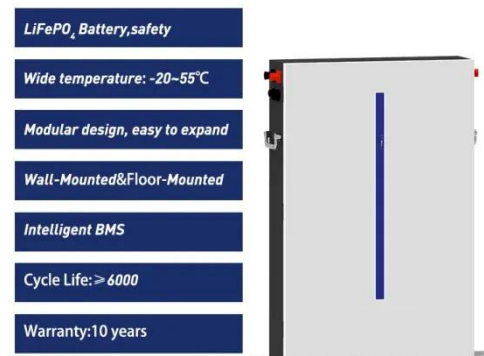

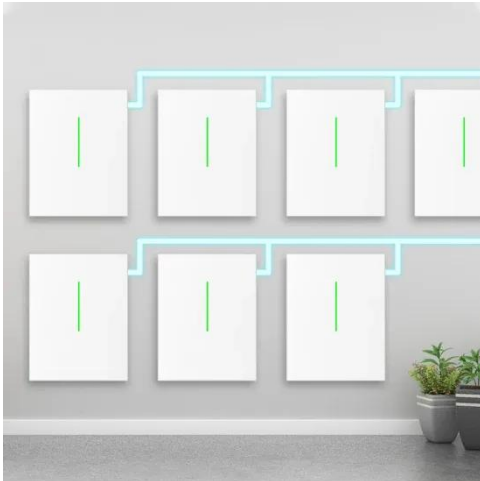
