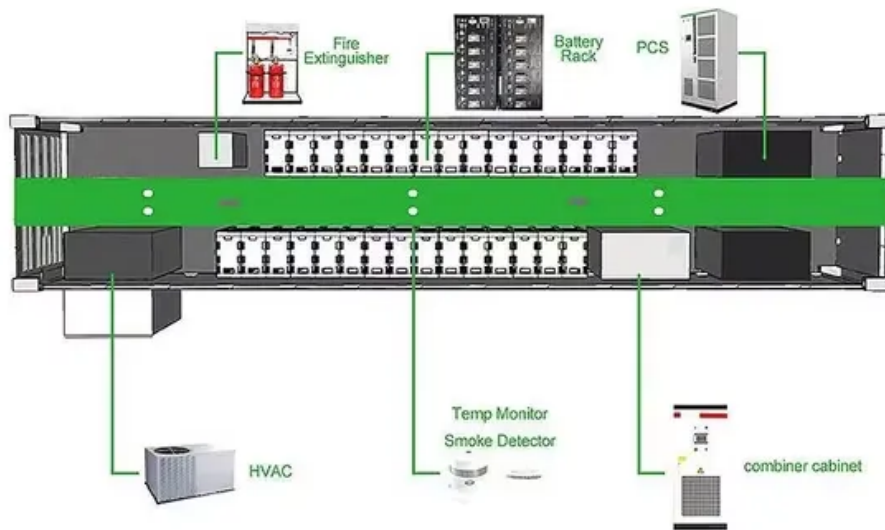


Can public housing be equipped with solar power generation

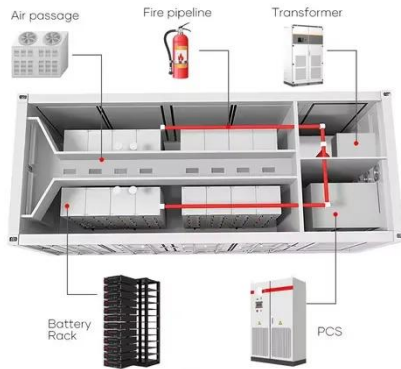
