Overview

As of 2021, there are more than 3,500 utility-scale solar projects in the United States. Millions of Americans – from California to Texas to New Hampshire - live near large solar projects. If a new solar project is proposed in your community, it is important to understand how the project will fit. More than 10 million U. homes sit within three miles of a solar farm. A new national survey looks into how people feel about having these large renewable energy projects as their neighbors. Scientists surveyed. Sure, you're a fan of solar energy and its benefits, but do you really want to live next to a solar plant?

We'll highlight the advantages and disadvantages of living next to a solar farm to help you understand whether this is something you want to do. Smaller-scale installations – including solar panels on things like homes and public buildings – have also seen sharp growth. The new Center survey asked Americans how common. 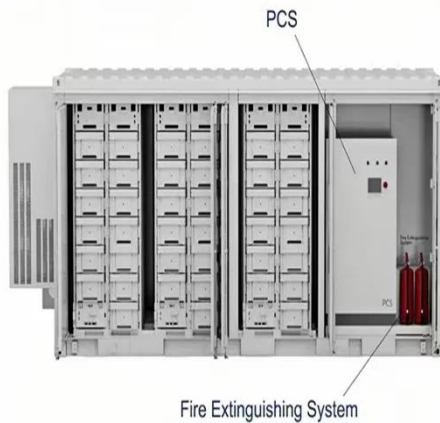

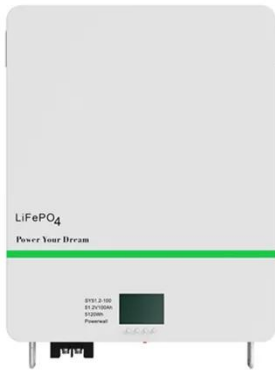
How Do Neighbors of Solar Farms Really Feel? A New Survey Has ...
