The average current output of a solar panel generally falls between 5 and 10 amps under ideal circumstances, such as clear skies and proper alignment towards the sun. 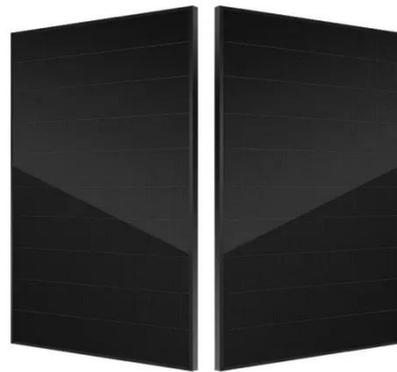

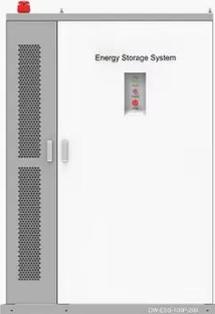
