Limited Range: Most EVs have a limited range, typically between 150-250 miles, before needing to be recharged. Charging Infrastructure: While charging infrastructure is improving, it can still be difficult to find public charging stations, particularly in rural areas. In the period January-March 2025, battery electric car (BEV) registrations reached 23,019 units, an increase of 75. Driving the growth is a combination of targeted incentives, expansion of supply and increased environmental awareness. Italy has seen a significant shift toward electric and hybrid vehicles (EVs and HEVs) in recent years, driven by environmental concerns, governmental incentives, and advancements in car technology. 84% of the electric vehicles offered on the market cost between €20,000-80,000, while the price range < €20,000, which for ICE vehicles represents the segment with the best-selling cars, is not currently fully. 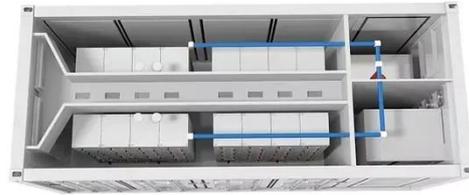
