Residents of the capital have the most electric vehicles – 2,963, residents of the Minsk region own 1,488 electric cars, Brest – 503, Grodno – 488, Homel – 408, Vitsiebsk – 303, Mahilou – 260. In 2020 Lukashenka signed a decree on supporting the development of. MINSK, 5 August (BelTA) – The electric transport sector has been gaining momentum in Belarus following Presidential Decree No. 92, Andrei Kotik, Deputy Director General for Construction and General Affairs at Belorusneft, told BelTA. As of 1 July 2025 there were 33,930 registered electric vehicles. 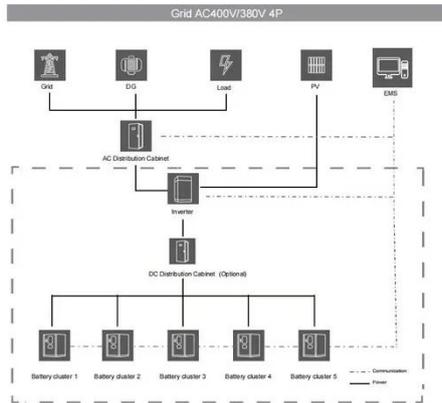
