Mali has begun construction on a major 200 MW solar power plant in Sanankoroba, 38 km south of Bamako, in partnership with Russian firm NovaWind. Covering 314 hectares, the project is set to be completed within a year and marks a key step in West Africa's renewable energy progress. Sanankoroba Solar Power Station is a 200 MW (270,000 hp) solar power plant under construction in Mali. The power plant is in development under a public private partnership (PPP) arrangement between the government of Mali and NovaWind, a subsidiary of the Russian conglomerate Rosatom. 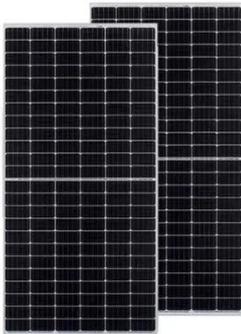
